### SHOE DRIVE: Oct 15<sup>th</sup> - Dec 14<sup>th</sup> to Support Myra and St. Andrews Comfort Dog Ministry

Did you know that over 600 million shoes go into landfills across the U.S. annually? The majority of these shoes can still be worn.

The Comfort Dog Ministry team with the assistance of Funds2Orgs, a professional fund raising organization is collecting gently worn, used and new shoes to support Myra and the Comfort Dog Ministry as well as small business owners in developing nations like Haiti, Colombia and Tanzania.

You can help by donating any gently worn, used shoes. Shoes can be of any size, gender and season. They should still have life in them; that is, the soles are intact, they have laces (if necessary), there are no holes or torn seams, and they are dry. Consider this: If you would not give them to a friend, they should not be submitted to the collection.

**Collection boxes will be prominently displayed in the narthex and school area.**

Our goal is 2,500 pairs of shoes in the 60-day collection period. Help us by starting in your family's closets and gathering pairs of shoes that you've outgrown, are out of style, or out of season. Ask family, friends, neighbors and co-workers to do the same. Every pair is one pair closer to our goal.
