As we head toward the Fall, we have much for which to give thanks! The start of school has been WONDERFUL, and it is so much fun to see the kids at school every day. Ms. Boggs and our school staff have done a simply amazing job creating an effective, and more importantly, safe plan for reopening. It has been a long summer of planning, but what a blessing to be able open up again. Our numbers are intentionally small this year, and it will not be an easy year financially, but we are doing what we are called to as a congregation in this difficult times.

As we look to the Fall, we are going to be changing up our worship schedule after Labor Day. On the weekend of September 12/13, we will have our usual Saturday Night Contemporary Worship Service at 5pm. This service will be in-person and live-casted every week. On Sundays, we will meet outside at 10am to account for our growing Sunday worship numbers (Check standrewsparkridge.org for updates on changes due to weather). We will do this as long as the weather consistently allows. As the weather gets cooler, we will move back inside for the winter months on Sunday. At this point we will shift our live-cast from Saturday Night back to a traditional Sunday service. I know some are not happy that we will not be live-casting a traditional worship service starting September 13, but this should only be the case for a few weeks, and I know everyone will be willing to make sacrifices in the short-term and for the benefit of our hard-working volunteers.
