**MISSION OF THE MONTH: Exodus World Services**, our October Mission of the Month, is dedicated to helping refugees, people who have fled their homes to save their lives. **Exodus** works with churches to make life a little easier for these people who need friendship and a place to belong. One of the ways that churches can help refugees is by putting together a Welcome to America Pack. A congregation collects and delivers items for a refugee family's kitchen, bath and bedroom, making an empty apartment into a home. These packs also contain a first month's supply of food. Volunteers meet refugee families on their first day in the United States and personally welcome them with the essentials to help them get started. St. Andrews knows about Welcome to America Packs because we have participated in the program a number of times.

Provide requested personal and payment information. or scroll down to "Find a walker or team" and type in St. Andrews. Provide requested information.
