IRA UPDATE FOR 2021: During 2020, the CARES Act created a holiday for required minimum distributions from IRAs. The CARES Act holiday for required minimum distributions from IRAs was not extended in 2021. IRA owners age 72 and older will resume their required minimum distribution (RMD) from IRAs. Fortunately, the law remains that IRA owners age 70½ and older can make a charitable rollover gift of up to \$100,000 from their IRA directly to a public charity. This charitable IRA rollover will count toward their RMDs. This will avoid a personal taxable event.

ST. PAUL OF THE CROSS FOOD PANTRY: Food drop-off days in February for the Food Pantry will be Saturdays, February 6, 13, and 20. The pantry has a need for pasta sauce, canned fruit, and cookies. NO PAPER GOODS are needed at this time. Previous generous donations have given the pantry ample supply for now. On the February drop-off days bring food donations to the rear entrance of St. Andrews between 11:00 am and 1:00 pm.
