MISSION OF THE MONTH: Most pastors and deaconesses involved in **LCMS Hispanic Ministry** were trained at Concordia Seminary in St. Louis in the Center for Hispanic Studies. Every three years, these workers in Hispanic ministry gather for the National Hispanic Convention. Pastors, deaconesses, and lay leaders from LCMS Hispanic congregations meet with district presidents and some LCMS missionaries from Latin America and the Caribbean as well as the president of the Lutheran Synod of Mexico. They exhibit resources and compare notes on Hispanic ministry in the United States. At the last convention in Houston discussion topics included How to Start a Hispanic Ministry, Strategies for Conducting Bilingual Services, and a report from the Lutheran Immigration and Refugee Services. Workers can also find resources and ideas at the website lcms.org/espanol. (This website also lists and provides service times for all of the 71 synodical churches that offer Spanish language worship services.) More and more, the Lutheran Church—Missouri Synod is responding to the growth of the Hispanic/Latino population in our country with the message of the Gospel.
