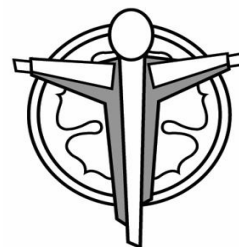

It takes creative and intentional effort to help individuals, families, and even congregations to read, hear, and interact with Scriptures within their daily activities. The Bible has no impact unless the Word engages people deeply within." LBT explains that locally-driven outreach is the goal. QUALIFIED CHARITABLE DEDUCTIONS (QCD):...still a great source for charitable gifts to St. Andrews and the ministries you are about. Basically, the same rules as in 2020.

- A direct transfer of funds from your IRA to a qualified charity
- Not taxable and counts toward your RMD
- Donors must be 70.5 or older
- Maximum annual amount that can qualify is \$100,000
- RMDs (Required Minimum Distribution) are back in 2021
- New \$300.00 single/\$600.00 married above the line charitable deduction for those filing the Standard Deduction for 2021
