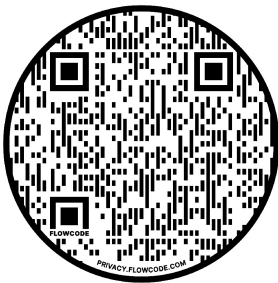

**QUALIFIED CHARITABLE DEDUCTIONS (QCD):**...still a great source for charitable gifts to St. Andrews and the ministries you are about. Basically, the same rules as in 2020.

- A direct transfer of funds from your IRA to a qualified charity
- Not taxable and counts toward your RMD
- Donors must be 70.5 or older
- Maximum annual amount that can qualify is \$100,000
- RMDs (Required Minimum Distribution) are back in 2021
- New \$300.00 single/\$600.00 married above the line charitable deduction for those filing the Standard Deduction for 2021
