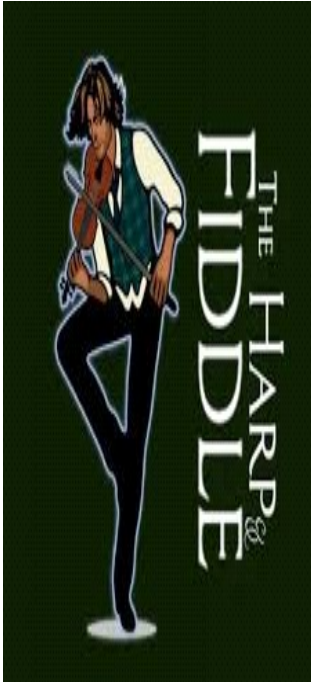
The students will begin their school year on Monday, August 23, 2021.
