**MISSION OF THE MONTH:** St. Matthew Lutheran Church was organized on New Year's Eve of 1871 by a small group of German immigrants. They laid a cornerstone for a church building in 1872, but the church was destroyed by fire in 1887. However, the current structure was built quickly thereafter, and it was consecrated in 1888. The congregation flourished and served the German community in Pilsen for many years. As the population of Pilsen became largely Hispanic, St. Matthew adapted to serve that new population which is largely poor with many residents who are unemployed and homeless. It is to this new reality that our mission of the month **Comedor San Mateo Soup Kitchen** came into being.
