MISSION OF THE MONTH: LCMS involvement in the work of Argentina's Lutheran ministry did not stop when Iglesia Evangelica Luterana Argentina was founded. **LCMS Ministry to Argentina**, our Mission of the Month, continues with our partner church body in a variety of ways. An important contribution to the work of Argentina Lutherans is the LCMS e-book distribution of important theology books translated into Spanish. LCMS also participates in conferences dealing with such issues as family and community health at the Mercy Center of Argentina's Lutheran Seminary. Most recently, LCMS representatives led disaster response workshops to help with frequent flooding problems in Argentina. The work of a single LCMS missionary in 1905 has grown into the largest Spanish-speaking church in Latin America. God be praised!

It will be replaced by a new App, called "Vanco Mobile". The new App is already available in the Apple App store and Google Play store. We are currently working with Vanco to set up St Andrews in the new App - we should be on the system shortly. In the meantime, you can continue to use the GivePlus App to make donations...and you can download the new Vanco Mobile App and verify that your current user ID and password work in the new App. Current App users will be receiving emails from Vanco (not from St Andrews) on September 22nd and September 29th to introduce the new App.
