**NEW VANCO GIVING APP:** If you have the Vanco GivePlus App on your phone, please be aware that the current App will stop working after September 30th. It will be replaced by a new App, called "Vanco Mobile". The new App is already available in the Apple App store and Google Play store. We are currently working with Vanco to set up St Andrews in the new App - we should be on the system shortly. In the meantime, you can continue to use the GivePlus App to make donations...and you can download the new Vanco Mobile App and verify that your current user ID and password work in the new App. Current App users will be receiving emails from Vanco (not from St Andrews) on September 22nd and September 29th to introduce the new App.

**IRA CHARITABLE ROLLOVERS:** During 2020, the Cares Act created a holiday for required minimum distributions from IRAs. The Cares Act holiday for required minimum distributions was not extended in 2021. IRA owners age 72 and older will resume their required minimum distribution (RMD) from IRAs. Fortunately, the law remains that IRA owners age 70.5 and older can make a charitable rollover gift of up to \$100,000 from their IRA directly to a public charity. This charitable IRA rollover will count toward their RMDs. This will avoid a personal taxable event.
