MISSION OF THE MONTH: Our mission of the month **Redeeming Life Outreach Ministry** came into being as the result of a long-term dream of Sheryl DeWitt, wife of Rev. Edward DeWitt who is pastor of The Lutheran Church of the Redeemer in Sanford, Florida. Sheryl had long dreamed of opening a Christian maternity home in a vacant house directly across the street from the church. She and her husband were able to secure the necessary donations to buy the house, renovate it, and then open it for pregnant women needing assistance. Since 2013, this maternity home has welcomed women who were usually homeless with insufficient money to live on their own. Many of them were undernourished and had no plans for their future. Some of the women were victims of addiction and abuse, and almost all of them had never experienced God's loving grace. These women were welcomed into the home-like setting of the house in Sanford where they experience daily Bible classes, non-judgmental counseling, job training, and practical preparation for the birth of their babies.
