NEWS AND EVENTS:

SHARE THE JOY: The message of Jesus during His earthly ministry did not sit well with the religious leaders of the day. That same message may not sit well during our time either. It doesn't fit the materialistic model of our time, nor does it mesh with the ideal of rugged individualism that is popular with many. Jesus was an itinerant preacher, a man who called a variety of undistinguished men to follow Him in His ministry. Jesus did not try to win a popularity contest but instead reached out to the weak, the needy, and those who recognized their spiritual inferiority. Jesus shared with them the joy of His salvation. As His followers, this is our task also.

MISSION OF THE MONTH: Today as we celebrate our Lord's resurrection in our beautiful church and look forward to Easter dinners with our families, please do not forget that in Ukraine, many people will be sheltering in underground shelters to escape the shelling and bombing of their cities. In some cases, they have been cut off from food, water, fuel, and electricity for days. Many health facilities have been destroyed, leaving people needing medical attention at great risk. The enormity of this crisis is difficult to comprehend, and it is easy to feel deep despair when trying to respond to our Lord's command to help our neighbors. Thankfully, **Lutheran World Relief** has been on the ground in Ukraine and neighboring countries since the war began. It has air-lifted personal hygiene kits and handmade quilts, as well as food and water. The organization is working with local experts to support critical health services by delivering critical medical supplies. It has also distributed emergency funds where the needs are the greatest. This war delivers death and destruction on a daily basis and endangers everyone who is still in the country. On this day when we celebrate the most important event of our Christian faith, let us not forget our Lord's injunction to serve those in need. We cannot go to Ukraine, but we can contribute to **Lutheran World Relief**, our representative in this war-torn part of the world.
