NEWS AND EVENTS:

MISSION OF THE MONTH: The war is still waging in Ukraine, spreading death and destruction throughout that country. It is difficult to watch what is happening to families, the elderly, and those with disabilities. Destruction is so widespread that returning to the homes left behind seems almost impossible. However, we need to remember that God can and does bring good out of evil, and that He expects His people to help those who are affected by evil. Last month we supported the Lutheran World Relief effort to provide aid in the Ukraine conflict. This month, our Mission of the Month is the **Lutheran Church Charities** aid effort in Ukraine.
