### NEWS AND EVENTS:

**MISSION OF THE MONTH:** Pastor Scott Yount and his wife Lena serve at the Ukraine Mission Center. Pastor Yount is the main Ukrainian contact for the mission of the month **Lutheran Church Charities** war relief effort. LCC wants donors to know that every cent donated for Ukrainian relief actually goes to that purpose. All LCC relief is sent directly to Lutheran Ukrainian pastors to help Ukrainians who are suffering. There is currently a massive shortage of available food and other essentials in Ukraine, so LCC has made a connection with Pastor Sarin-Horia Trifa of the Confessional Lutheran Church in Romania to purchase life-saving food and medicines that will be transported to the border of Ukraine for distribution by Ukrainian Lutheran pastors. Pastor Sergey Bavz of the Lutheran church in Dnipro reports that he receives 200-300 phone calls each day from people in need of shelter, food, and medicines. He says that every square meter of his church is being used to provide temporary shelter for refugees before they move to the border. He reports, "Our little church team consists of church members who sent their family members abroad and volunteers living nearby. We are grateful to you, dear friends, that you are also participating in this ministry. Your support allows us to continue to help many people who have been affected by the war." A gift to **Lutheran Church Charities—Ukraine** will provide important relief to Ukrainians suffering from the war.

**SHARE THE JOY:** When Jesus walked the dusty paths during His earthly ministry, he reached out to and lovingly served folks of every gender, ethnicity, and social level. He did not exclude anyone. He expects us to follow His example. We are not doing that if we withhold the Good News from any individual or group, if we refuse to reach out to people with whom we feel uncomfortable. God's directive to Share the Joy does not allow us to pick and choose.
