NEWS AND EVENTS:

THANK YOU: Dear St. Andrews friends, we thank you for your prayers for our son, Tim, and for all of the serving military. Tim Paschke is now retired from the U.S. Air Force after 22 years and many deployments to Iraq, Afghanistan, Turkey, Africa and the Baltic. We are very grateful for your prayers - Barb and Al Paschke.

MISSION OF THE MONTH: The aid effort in Ukraine by our Mission of the Month **Lutheran Church Charities** is directed primarily through Lutheran churches in Ukraine. Retired pastor and US Air Force Reserve Chaplain Rev. Larry Myer, is the LCC staff person who is in charge of directing critical aid to Ukrainian citizens affected by the violence and devastation that continues in the Ukraine War. Families of pastors in the Synod of Evangelical Lutheran Church of Ukraine have been evacuated, but the pastors and key congregants have stayed behind to continue Word and Sacrament ministry as they also provide humanitarian assistance. **Lutheran Church Charities** assistance is directed to Ukrainians through the 24 established congregations in the SELCU. These Lutheran churches are feeding and clothing displaced persons as well as transporting refugees to the Romanian border.

SHARE THE JOY: In his book *A Bigger Table*, John Pavlovitz notes that many church communities are "gentrified, sanitized, and homogenized," and have no room for anyone who is deemed "too ragged, too left of center, or too difficult to deal with." Lest we enjoy too much the fact that St. Andrews is full of pleasant people just like us, remember how our Lord often engaged with the least desirable members of His society: prostitutes, tax collectors, beggars, and lepers. Will we be open enough to seek greater diversity in our worshiping community? Our Lord commanded us to reach out to ALL PEOPLE!

FOOD PANTRY: There is a special need for the following items at the FOOD PANTRY: canned fruit, shampoo, toilet paper, and paper towels.
