

NEWS AND EVENTS:

MISSION OF THE MONTH: Mission of the Month Food for the Poor not only provides emergency relief to impoverished people in Latin America and the Caribbean, it strives for long-term solutions to poverty. Food for the Poor sets up educational opportunities and micro-enterprise projects to raise people out of the generational cycle of poverty that holds them in its grip. The organization's website tells us, "We do our best to meet needs, both physical and spiritual."

SHARE THE JOY: A 2018 study in the American Journal of Epidemiology examines how being raised in a family with religious beliefs affects mental health. Harvard researchers examined the religious involvement of 5,000 families and found that children and teens who attended weekly religious services scored higher on psychological measurements of well-being and had lower risk of mental illness than those who did not participate in religious worship. Sadly, the United States has seen a 20% decrease in religious worship in the past 20 years. We need to Share the Joy with parents and encourage them to bring their children to church with them.

FOOD PANTRY UPDATE: 123 clients used the Food Pantry in May. A new client commented that donors to this food pantry are wonderful because the food is so good and that donors care so much. Our continual support is really appreciated by the people who use the pantry. **NOTE:** Food and paper products, toilet paper in particular, will be especially needed during the summer.

LCMS GIFT PLANNING: Qualified Charitable Deductions (QCD)...still a great source for charitable gifts to St. Andrews and the ministries you care about.

Basically, the same rules as in 2021: A direct transfer of funds from your IRA to a qualified charity

- Not a taxable event and counts toward Required Minimum Distribution (RMD)
- Donors mus be 70-1/2 or older
- Maximum annual amount that can qualify is \$100,000
- In addition, there is a \$300.00 single/\$600.00 married above the line charitable deduction for those filing the Standard Deduction for 2022
