MISSION OF THE MONTH: Though its focus has always been poverty in Latin America and the Caribbean, Food for the Poor is now responding to the war in Ukraine by partnering with Feed My Starving Children to bring relief to Ukrainians in need. Because of the war, no crops are being planted or harvested in this former "European breadbasket," where a terrible humanitarian crisis has developed. This partnership is distributing desperately-needed food through the auspices of Mission Eurasia, a trusted network of Christian pastors. Your help is needed. Both options allow you to make one time donations or to set up regularly scheduled (weekly or monthly) donations, and to designate the purpose of your donation. Try them out if you like donating electronically!

FOOD PANTRY UPDATE: ESPECIALLY NEEDED ITEMS: Especially needed items vary from week to week. Items that are currently running low include chunky soups, mac and cheese, and grape and strawberry jelly. Paper products like toilet paper and paper towels are always welcome also.

CONCERNS OF POLICE SURVIVORS: Help Officer Jenny Bulinski raise money to support families and co-workers who lost loved ones in the line of duty. Through a non-profit organization called Concerns of Police Survivors, she will be walking, running, biking, and swimming for 563 minutes in the month of July. 563 is the number of police officers who lost their lives in the line of duty in 2021 and 2022 thus far. LCMS GIFT PLANNING: Qualified Charitable Deductions (QCD)...still a great source for charitable gifts to St. Andrews and the ministries you care about. Basically, the same rules as in 2021: A direct transfer of funds from your IRA to a qualified charity

- Not a taxable event and counts toward Required Minimum Distribution (RMD)
- Donors must be 70-1/2 or older
- Maximum annual amount that can qualify is \$100,000
- In addition, there is a \$300.00 single/\$600.00 married above the line charitable deduction for those filing the Standard Deduction for 2022
