NEWS AND EVENTS:

MISSION OF THE MONTH: The Lutheran Church—Missouri Synod **Ministry to the Blind** is our current mission of the month. In 1923, the LCMS Mission Board directed the Mission Board for the Deaf to investigate the possibility of publishing religious magazines in Braille. In 1926, the first issue of Lutheran Messenger for the Blind appeared. In 1947 a special board for **Ministry to the Blind** was elected. Since then, synodical work among the blind has expanded considerably.

SHARE THE JOY: In his book *Advanced Missiology*, Kenneth Nehrbass observes that the global missionary force is becoming more and more diverse. Whereas, previously, the missionary force consisted primarily of highly educated missionaries from Western countries, it now includes humble Christians with less education, and more and more Gospel spreaders being indigenous followers of Christ. In other words, laymen and laywomen are the predominant missionaries in many less developed countries. Do you have the notion that only trained theologians are qualified to make evangelism calls on non-Christians? Christianity is spreading in parts of Africa and South America, while Christian churches in North America and Europe are declining. Do you see any lesson here for effective Gospel-sharing? Wait no longer, members of St. Andrews—Share the Joy!
