NEWS AND EVENTS:

MISSION OF THE MONTH: An important part of the LCMS **Ministry to the Blind** is an organization known as Lutheran Braille Workers. This organization exists to bring the Good News to millions of people worldwide who are blind or visually impaired. They produce Bibles and other religious materials in Braille, specialized large print, and audio formats. Lutheran Braille Workers cooperate with individual congregations and other organizations that serve the blind.

SHARE THE JOY: Globally, about 244 million people live outside the country of their birth. International students make up a large number of this global diaspora. Over 65 million people have been violently forced to find refuge outside their home country. In addition, more and more people immigrate to other countries for employment opportunities. As a result, we find that many people currently residing in the United States were born elsewhere. Whatever the reason for immigrating to the US, the people who come here will usually have difficulties with language and cultural differences. The biblical command to love our neighbor covers all people from all ethnic groups. Organizations like Exodus work to help these new neighbors adjust to their new living situations. One way you can Share the Joy is to reach out to these new residents with the hand of friendship and support. Exodus is headquartered right here in Park Ridge, so volunteering is easy.

MAKING DONATIONS ELECTRONICALLY: There are two ways to donate to St Andrews electronically - you can use either a smart phone app (VancoMobile) or our website (standrewsparkridge.org). The QR code at the top of the front page will take you directly to the website donation page - no need to enter the URL, and no need to use the "Click HERE to Give" link on that page. Both options allow you to make one time donations or to set up regularly scheduled (weekly or monthly) donations, and to designate the purpose of your donation. Try them out if you like donating electronically!

FOOD PANTRY UPDATE: ESPECIALLY NEEDED ITEMS: Especially needed items vary from week to week. Items that are currently running low include chunky soups, mac and cheese, and grape and strawberry jelly. Paper products like toilet paper and paper towels are always welcome also.

CONCERNS OF POLICE SURVIVORS: Help Officer Jenny Bulinski raise money to support families and co-workers who lost loved ones in the line of duty. Through a non-profit organization called Concerns of Police Survivors, she will be walking, running, biking, and swimming for 563 minutes in the month of July. 563 is the number of police officers who lost their lives in the line of duty in 2021 and 2022 thus far.
