MISSION OF THE MONTH: The website of the Lutheran Church—Missouri Synod reminds us that “Jesus wants His church to have open doors, welcoming all people to worship.” It is the case, however, that people with disabilities are much less likely to be in worship and participate in the life of a congregation. Among those who are disabled are those with vision issues. Our mission of the month is our church’s **ministry to the blind.**

SHARE THE JOY: The early Christians faced a pagan culture based on the worship of Greek and Roman idols as well as emperor worship. Missionaries today often face danger from opposing cultures in the countries where they work. Belief in Christ often supports values that differ substantially from the cultural landscape in which we live. In our country where we are allowed to worship as we please, we do not live in a religious bubble. We often face issues that directly conflict with our witness of Christ crucified and risen again. Our Christian faith is the source of great joy. Don’t hoard it—Share the Joy!
