MISSION OF THE MONTH: Our July Mission of the Month is the LCMS **Ministry to the Blind**. An important part of this ministry now meets the needs of prison chaplains and prison officials who can order Bibles and religious materials suited to the needs of their institutions directly from Lutheran Braille Workers. The LCMS **Ministry to the Blind** also provides direction and resources to congregations wishing to develop an outreach to people who are blind. It is all part of a ministry designed to bring the light of the Gospel to people who live in physical darkness.

MAKING DONATIONS ELECTRONICALLY: There are two ways to donate to St Andrews electronically - you can use either a smart phone app (VancoMobile) or our website (standrewsparkridge.org). Both options allow you to make one time donations or to set up regularly scheduled (weekly or monthly) donations, and to designate the purpose of your donation. FOOD PANTRY ITEMS NEEDED: Please consider donating the following items to the Food Pantry: meals in a can, such as spaghetti, ravioli, hash, canned ham. Also chunky soups, mac and cheese, grape and strawberry jelly, 1 & 2 lb bags of rice are needed. Toilet paper and paper towels are also much appreciated items.

LUTHERAN WORLD RELIEF SCHOOL SUPPLIES: Following the worship services on the weekend of August 6 & 7 there will be a door collection to purchase school supplies for Lutheran World Relief. The Board of Service Ministry will fill 100 backpacks with the supplies at its September meeting.

CONCERNS OF POLICE SURVIVORS: Help Officer Jenny Bulinski raise money to support families and co-workers who lost loved ones in the line of duty. Through a non-profit organization called Concerns of Police Survivors, she will be walking, running, biking, and swimming for 563 minutes in the month of July. 563 is the number of police officers who lost their lives in the line of duty in 2021 and 2022 thus far.
