NEWS AND EVENTS:

MISSION OF THE MONTH: The LCMS Medical Mercy Teams Ministry, our Mission of the Month, provides desperately needed health care to our brothers and sisters around the world alongside the Gospel. Teams of volunteer health care professionals—doctors, nurses, and pharmacists—along with lay volunteers, work together with International partners to bring relief and healing in the name of Christ. Often the areas which teams serve have no health care providers, so teams set up clinics where patients can be seen. One of the other efforts of such teams is to teach community health classes. Basic hygiene practices and nutrition are important topics for such classes.

SHARE THE JOY: In his book *Advanced Missiology*, Alvin L. Reid provides this heading for one of the chapters: "The Power of One: The Reason You Live." In this chapter the author discusses the need for commitment by individual Christians to share the Good News in their daily lives among family, friends, and co-workers. It often seems much easier to ask professionals and church organizations to do what God calls every one of His children to do. However, we are not given a way out of the Great Commission to which all of us as individuals are called. EACH OF US is called to share the joy!

MAKING DONATIONS ELECTRONICALLY: There are two ways to donate to St Andrews electronically - you can use either a smart phone app (VancoMobile) or our website (standrewsparkridge.org). The QR code at the top of the front page will take you directly to the website donation page - no need to enter the URL, and no need to use the "Click HERE to Give" link on that page. Both options allow you to make one time donations or to set up regularly scheduled (weekly or monthly) donations, and to designate the purpose of your donation. Try them out if you like donating electronically!

FOOD PANTRY ITEMS NEEDED: Please consider donating the following items to the Food Pantry: meals in a can, such as spaghetti, ravioli, hash, canned ham. Also chunky soups, mac and cheese, grape and strawberry jelly, 1 & 2 lb bags of rice are needed. Toilet paper and paper towels are also much appreciated items.

PROPERTY TAX INFO: A member made us aware of a property tax reduction opportunity that he'd recently used. He suggested that we share information about it, as some other members may also qualify for the exemption. It's available for homeowners with disabilities.
