**MISSION OF THE MONTH:** A volunteer returning from a mission trip with LCMS Medical Mercy Teams Ministry was quoted saying, "I'm still not sure how we treat so many patients during our clinics. All I know is that God makes it happen. His hurting people show up and He uses our team members' hands, heads, and hearts to heal their body and soul." In regions with little or no health care, our August Mission of the Month brings the physical healing which opens a door for sharing the Gospel. Volunteers do not always see the results of their Gospel sharing—that often happens after the team is gone through local church partners who follow up with those who have been treated at the clinic.
