MISSION OF THE MONTH: Dr. James A Banech is the executive director of the LCMS Office of Pastoral Education. Speaking about our mission of the month, **Set Apart to Serve**, he emphasizes that this initiative is not just designed to recruit bodies to fill the various offices of the church, nor is it "just an attempt to reverse a decline in church workers. Rather **Set Apart to Serve** seeks to form pastors and church workers to hand over the saving faith to God's people, passing on the Christian faith from one generation to the next until our Savior returns."

SHARE THE JOY: A "manifesto" from the Center for United States Missions contains this section. "We long to see people reconciled to God and to one another. However, we resist dividing the whole Gospel by separating Christ's command to love our neighbor from his commission to make disciples." FOOD PANTRY NEEDS: Thanks to all who faithfully donate to the Food Pantry. Items needed include cookies, pancake syrup, meals in a can, such as spaghettiOs, ravioli, hash, canned ham, chunky soups, mac and cheese, grape and strawberry jelly, 1 & 2 lb. bags of rice, brownie mix, cold cereal, toilet paper and paper towels. Unacceptable items include diapers/pampers, and oatmeal products of any kind.

HEARING ASSISTANCE: St Andrews has a system which amplifies the sound of our pastors, musicians and readers. Two types of receivers are available. One type clips to your ear, the second type is a loop that is worn around your neck and feeds the sound directly to your hearing aids (if they have telecoil capability). The receivers are stored on the pulpit, readily available for use. They're very easy to try. If you'd like to check them out, please ask Pastor Matt, Pastor Sam or John Snow for assistance.
