**MAKING DONATIONS ELECTRONICALLY:** There are two ways to donate to St Andrews electronically - you can use either a smart phone app (VancoMobile) or our website ([standrewsparkridge.org](http://standrewsparkridge.org)). The QR code at the top of the front page will take you directly to the website donation page - no need to enter the URL, and no need to use the "Click HERE to Give" link on that page. Both options allow you to make one time donations or to set up regularly scheduled (weekly or monthly) donations, and to designate the purpose of your donation.

**HEARING ASSISTANCE:** St Andrews has a system which amplifies the sound of our pastors, musicians and readers. Two types of receivers are available. One type clips to your ear, the second type is a loop that is worn around your neck and feeds the sound directly to your hearing aids (if they have telecoil capability). The receivers are stored on the pulpit, readily available for use. They're very easy to try. If you'd like to check them out, please ask Pastor Matt, Pastor Sam or John Snow for assistance.

**What has MYRA been up to? (May 11-24)**

Did you know that the K-9 Comfort Dogs have Biblical Names? Myra was a town in Lycia, about 85 miles from Antalya, Turkey. It is referenced in Acts 27:5 where Paul's voyage to Rome is describe. "...sailed over the sea of Cilicia and Pamphylia, we came to Myra a city of Lycia."

These two weeks included visits to The Garlands of Barrington, Arden Courts Memory Care in Elk Grove Village, Chicago Behavioral Hospital in DesPlaines, Avantara Rehab Center in Park Ridge and White Crane Adult Day Wellness Center in Chicago. She visits these facilities regularly and the many of the residents and staff have come to know her well and look forward to her visits. She also spent an afternoon with Mrs. Kress's class who won the auction bid for a visit with Myra and ice cream treats. That evening she was at Hoffman Elementary School in Glenview for a family reading night. Some of the children read to her in Spanish and were thrilled that Myra "understood" them. She also spent time at Winston Elementary School, Palatine with a class of autistic children and their teacher and various supportive staff. Myra did what she does best – loved them all and laid calmly in their midst. Then there were visits at Clearbrook in Palatine where she was joined by three Comfort Dogs that are in training; and a visit to Reavis High School in Burbank with another seasoned Comfort Dog. She ended this two week period with a visit to Lutheran Home in Arlington Heights.
