LCMS GIFT PLANNING: FAMILY GIFT FUND (DONOR ADVISED FUND)

FOOD PANTRY UPDATE: Along with the usual food items and paper products (those are always welcome), there is a current need for canned fruit, canned corn, canned beans, and packages of spaghetti. Thank you.

SHARE THE JOY: The Church is sometimes accused of promoting an exclusive club. In fact, it is often said that the most segregated time of the week is when church services are being held on Sunday morning. Pursuing multi-ethnicity in the Church is not about just making a few changes that will make it palatable for non-white folks. It is about making the structural changes needed to ensure that the experiences and voices of people of color will be fairly and appropriately represented and heard. It is about understanding how power plays a role and then finding ways to empower those who are on the margins. We must give honor and deference to each person's culture. As we lean into valuing one another, we will experience the power of our multi-ethnic body of Christ.

MISSION OF THE MONTH: One of the ways that **Lutheran Hour Ministries** reaches people in rural areas is through its Children's Program. For example LHM-Sri Lanka received a request for help for children too poor to buy school supplies. The LHM Ministry Center collected materials for school supply gift packs for children in the community. As a result, 30 adults began attending worship services at a local Lutheran mission. If you would like to help advance any of LHM's outreach programs, place an offering in a plain envelope marked "Lutheran Hour Ministries" and place it in the weekend offering.

MAKING DONATIONS ELECTRONICALLY: There are two ways to donate to St Andrews electronically - you can use either a smart phone app (VancoMobile) or our website (standrewsparkridge.org). The QR code at the top of the front page will take you directly to the website donation page - no need to enter the URL, and no need to use the "Click HERE to Give" link on that page. Both options allow you to make one time donations or to set up regularly scheduled (weekly or monthly) donations, and to designate the purpose of your donation.

HEARING ASSISTANCE: St Andrews has a system which amplifies the sound of our pastors, musicians and readers. Two types of receivers are available. One type clips to your ear, the second type is a loop that is worn around your neck and feeds the sound directly to your hearing aids (if they have telecoil capability). The receivers are stored on the pulpit, readily available for use. They're very easy to try. If you'd like to check them out, please ask Pastor Matt, Pastor Sam or John Snow for assistance.

No two stories are the same, but the constant suffering is.
