**MISSION OF THE MONTH:** Our mission of the month is **Mission to Brazil**. The first LCMS missionaries came to Brazil in 1900 at the request of German immigrants living in Brazil. The Brazilian church's first seminary, Seminario Concordia was established in 1903, and a year later in 1904, the Evangelical Lutheran Church of Brazil was formed in Rio Grande do Sul, a southern state of Brazil. In 1989 LCMS began mercy work in Brazil. The first grant helped special education students finish their high school education. Since then, dozens of grants from Synod's mercy arm have helped disaster response and human care efforts in Brazil.
