FOOD PANTRY UPDATE: 144 households visited the food pantry at St Paul of the Cross in April. Most needed items this month area pancake mix and syrup, 1lb WHITE rice and canned fruit. Thank you for your continuing support!

MISSION OF THE MONTH: Our May Mission of the Month is a Lutheran Heritage Foundation project called **"Help 4 Haiti."** The island nation of Haiti has suffered greatly from many difficult national disasters. In addition, violent gangs often roam the streets of Haiti's communities, making it difficult for people to carry on normal activities. People are often unable to attend church, and children frequently cannot get to their schools or Sunday Schools. Sometimes people have to flee their homes in the middle of the night with only the belongings that they can carry in their hands. **"Help 4 Haiti,"** aims to help children in such situations by providing them with hard-covered books such as A Child's Garden of Bible Stories and Luther's Small Catechism translated into Haitian Creole or Haitian French, the languages spoken in Haiti. In this way, children are able to have contact with the Good News even when they cannot attend school or Sunday School.

SHARE THE JOY: In a 1998 Concordia Publishing House Bible Study program called "Dare to be Different," Stephen D. Hower reminds us, "As God's Spirit equips us to shine brightly for Him who died for us and rose again, God's Word reminds us that no Christian witnesses alone. Through the same Spirit, God motivates and empowers us just as He provides us with opportunities to bring the Good News of Jesus to others." God is with us every step of the way as we share the joy.
