FOOD PANTRY UPDATE: 153 households visited the food pantry at St Paul of the Cross in May. Most needed items this month are pancake mix and syrup, canned corn, and toothpaste. Thank you for your continuing support!

MISSION OF THE MONTH: Feeding starving children around the world is the goal of our June Mission of the Month, **Feed My Starving Children**. The first shipment of **FMSC** MannaPack Rice was packed by volunteers and shipped to a pediatric hospital in war-torn Rwanda with the help of a partner organization called Blessing Meals. This first experience provided the model that is still used. Volunteers pack the food in plastic bags and the shipping is provided by food distribution partner charities, including Mercy Ships, that are active in the localities that receive the food. Today **FMSC** sends food packs to more than 70 countries. It is estimated 99% of all of their food shipments arrive safely.

Many people worldwide have not even heard the name of Christ. Our job is huge, but it is the challenge with which God has entrusted us. Let us not fail in our sacred mission.
